Because when we all Carry The Fire, The Princess Margaret will lead the world in transforming cancer survival rates and care – creating a world free from the fear of cancer.



CANADA'S SURVIVAL RATE FOR ALL CANCERS

Thanks to cancer research breakthroughs made possible through philanthropy, more people survive cancer today than ever before. Even so, cancer remains the leading cause of death in Canada, claiming the lives of approximately 1 in 4 Canadians.



More than half of all cancers are preventable: Researchers believe that over half of all cancer cases—and up to half of all cancer deaths—are preventable. This means there are between 2.4 million and 3.7 million avoidable deaths per year, 80% of which occur in low- and middle-income countries.

There are more than 200 types and subtypes of cancer: Cancer is not one disease. In the last 10 years, researchers have identified that there are more than 200 different types and subtypes of cancer – and The Princess Margaret is the only cancer centre in Canada that treats them all. This has triggered a shift away from a one-size-fits-all approach and toward “tailored therapy”.

There are 28 million cancer survivors worldwide: Thankfully, more people are surviving cancer than ever before. The Princess Margaret is a leader in designing holistic approaches to improve overall quality of health so that patients can not only survive, but thrive.

The Princess Margaret will be Canada's hub for the most innovative interventions available, leading the world in the development of new targeted treatments like theranostics and advanced immunotherapies, next generation surgical robotics, and more precise, targeted cancer medicines. These treatments have the potential to eventually replace traditional chemotherapy and ease the physical challenges often associated with cancer care.

As Canada's only multidisciplinary treatment centre dedicated solely to cancer and a world leader in cancer research innovation and care, Princess Margaret Cancer Centre is uniquely positioned to deliver on the promise of creating a world free from the fear of cancer.

The Princess Margaret drives cancer discovery, fuels advances in cancer care and shares innovations globally:

- Our **discovery of stem cells** made bone marrow transplants and the field of regenerative medicine possible.
- We developed the **world's first chemotherapy treatment** for hormone-resistant prostate cancer.
- **We made the field of immunotherapy possible**, expanding the range of treatment options from radiation, surgery, and chemotherapy, by cloning the human T-cell receptor to equip the body's own immune system to recognize and eliminate cancer cells.
- **We are pioneers in CAR-T therapy**, a form of immunotherapy that genetically modifies a patient's own T cells to attack cancer.
- We helped develop seven new drug treatments for multiple myeloma, **tripling survival rates** over the past 15 years.
- We established the lumpectomy and radiation as a standard treatment option for early-stage breast cancer, **replacing radical mastectomies** for many patients.
- **We discovered the link between breast density and breast cancer**, transforming mammography standards and breast cancer screening guidelines around the world and identifying a critical risk for breast cancer that is higher than family history.
- We have **one of the world's largest clinical trial programs** and since 2014, The Princess Margaret has played a foundational role in more than 75% of all new cancer drugs approved by Health Canada and the FDA.

Each of us has our own connection to cancer that motivates us to get involved. Together, we can improve cancer outcomes for people everywhere, for generations to come.
