We are proud to look back on a year that saw tremendous breakthroughs and advances in our understanding of cancer. While COVID has dominated the headlines over the last two years, understandably given its unprecedented impact on the health of our people and our healthcare systems, cancer continues to affect the lives of countless people.

Every day, more than 600 people in Canada are diagnosed with cancer, and more than 200 die from the disease – making cancer Canada’s leading cause of death. As Canada's population ages, it is anticipated that the number of cancer cases will only grow.

The pandemic brought even more complex challenges, including disruptions to screening, treatment, and surgeries. As a result, some experts fear that a greater number of Canadians will face late-stage cancer diagnoses in the coming years.

Princess Margaret Cancer Centre faced another challenging year, as we lived through waves of infection and new variants during the second year of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Unlocking New Treatments for the Most Common Type of Brain Tumour

Meningiomas are the most common type of brain tumour, yet they've been highly under-studied over the past 30 years.

Treatment has largely been limited to surgery and some use of radiation therapy; however, new research led by Senior Scientist Dr. Gelareh Zadeh's lab as part of the Macfeeters-Hamilton Neuro-Oncology Program has led to other viable medical treatment options for the first time ever.

"For many years, patients have often needed to have multiple rounds of surgery and radiation, with very limited lasting effects. Having the option of a medical treatment changes the landscape for our patients," says Dr. Zadeh.

The study discovered there are four distinct subtypes of meningiomas based on the integrated genomic and epigenomic characteristics of the tumours. Identifying these unique characteristics paves the way towards other treatments, based on the biological drivers of the tumours.

"This study is truly a reflection of the strength of The Princess Margaret and UHN environment where we can bring the talent and expertise together," says Dr. Zadeh.



New Cloud-Based Tool Enhances Collaboration in Cancer Research

Cancer data is complex to analyze, and subtle differences in the way it is processed could lead to seemingly conflicting results. A lack of transparency around data sets, as well as how they are created and processed, can make it difficult to replicate findings.

Committed to breaking down these barriers and increasing the quality of science, a team led by Senior Scientist Dr. Benjamin Haibe-Kains has designed and built a cloud-based tool – The ORCHEStration Tool for Reproducible Analysis (ORCESTRa) – that processes, annotates, curates and releases some of the world's most-used biomedical data.

With scientific discoveries made possible by building on the work of others, ORCESTRa provides data sets, detailed documentation, and computer code to share how raw data was processed.

"Science builds upon the work of others," says Dr. Haibe-Kains. "If you don't share the code and the data, then I would say more than half of the impact that you could have is gone."



Exploiting the Unique Metabolic Features of Cancer Cells

Probing the unique biology of human pancreatic cancer cells in a laboratory has yielded unexpected insights into a weakness that can be used against the cells to kill them.

Research led by Senior Scientist Dr. Marianne Koritzinsky discovered the same metabolic deregulation that promotes cancer cell growth can also create novel vulnerabilities. While studying patient-derived pancreatic cell lines, they found half of the cancer cell lines are dependent on the protein peroxiredoxin 4 (PRDX4) for survival due to the altered metabolic state of the cancer cell. With this dependency vital for survival, PRDX4 becomes a potential target.

Our researchers demonstrated targeting PRDX4 in these cancer cell lines led to toxic accumulation of oxidative stress, which leads to DNA damage, cell death, and impaired tumour growth in preclinical models. It was also discovered that the loss of PRDX4 had no measurable effect on normal cells. Targeting a protein needed only by a cancer cell opens the door to more treatment options, and ones with less toxicity.

Taken together, this body of work reveals the potential of targeted therapies to exploit unique metabolic features of cancer cells that are far more specific than, for example, chemotherapy which affects both cancer and normal cells.

"It's not hard to kill cancer cells," says Dr. Koritzinsky, "It's hard to kill cancer cells without harming the cancer patient."



Discovering a Vulnerability in Central Nervous System Leukemia

A new detailed molecular portrait of central nervous system leukemia cells developed by Senior Scientist Dr. John Dick's lab has found a possible weakness in the illness, which could pave the way to a new treatment for patients.

A common site for leukemia relapse is the central nervous system, and previously treatments that specifically targeted the biology for these leukemia cells did not exist.

The team of scientists, including study co-authors, Dr. Robert Vanner, University of Toronto Medical Oncology resident, and Dr. Stephanie Dobson, University of Ottawa pediatrics resident, made the discovery using preclinical models of acute lymphoblastic leukemia.

While investigating the different gene expression programs within those cells in each area of the body, they found clear differences in the cellular production of proteins. This distinction could mean that cancer cells in the brain may be vulnerable to a new drug therapy.

Their research showed a currently available drug – once thought to be ineffective for treating acute lymphoblastic leukemia – could make a difference for individuals whose illness has spread to the central nervous system, resulting in potentially less harmful side effects.

Early Detection

Developing simple ways to find cancer earlier, when it's the most curable.

Imagine a world where a simple blood test can detect cancer before you ever have symptoms. That world is possible, because of researchers at The Princess Margaret such as **Drs. Daniel De Carvalho** (pictured above) and **Scott Bratman**, who developed a blood test to detect and classify cancer at its earliest stages. Our technology has the potential to revolutionize how we detect and diagnose cancer, monitor treatment response, and identify patients who are at a higher risk of relapse and might benefit from more aggressive treatment.

Cancer Without Chemo

Personalizing cancer care with less-toxic and higher precision therapies.

Every patient is unique, and so is their cancer. That's why we're continuing to personalize cancer care and harness the latest technologies to predict individual patient responses to treatment. This helps ensure that we're providing the best, most appropriate care and avoiding unnecessary treatment. We're also moving toward minimally invasive procedures and high-precision therapies that target cancerous cells, while sparing healthy ones.

Digital Health Intelligence & AI

Harnessing digital intelligence to improve the cancer experience.

Our team is focused on maximizing digital intelligence to improve discoveries, patient care delivery, and the overall cancer experience through the fusion of human wisdom, data and technology. From applying artificial intelligence and machine learning methods, to improving cancer knowledge and care, and advancing remote patient monitoring programs, we aspire to be a global leader in the application of digital intelligence.

Dr. Kim shares, “The program's goal is to demonstrate that universal genetic testing can lead to the identification of cancer susceptibility genes that otherwise would have gone undetected, therefore allowing for earlier intervention and better patient outcomes.”




Today's Ideas Lead to Tomorrow's Breakthroughs



Want a say in the next big breakthrough in cancer research? Our **Invest in Research** program provides the unique opportunity for donors to stand at the forefront of innovation and to support some of the brightest minds at The Princess Margaret.

Every year, Invest in Research donors review a short list of proposals from Princess Margaret scientists who are working on new and innovative cancer research projects. Tapping into their entrepreneurial spirit, donors then vote in a 'Dragons' Den' style to decide which bold projects deserve a chance to receive \$100,000 grants.

Thanks to the generosity of Invest in Research donors, we've awarded grants to three promising projects this year:



Dr. Natasha Leigh is testing the efficacy of liquid biopsies in diagnosing advanced non-small cell lung cancer with the non-invasive blood test offering the potential to reduce wait times between diagnosis and treatment, which can affect survival, symptom control, and quality of life.



Dr. Shane Harding and his team are studying radiation in the context of prostate cancer to better understand how cells respond to radiotherapy at the molecular level and identify how it can be better used with immunotherapy to improve survival rates.



Dr. Eric Lechman and his team are looking to improve the understanding of how the presence of an extra chromosome 21 influences leukemia initiation in children with Down syndrome, and the mechanisms the study uncovers may also reveal the genetic alterations that cause leukemia in adults.

In fact, for some cancer types, GTx can lead to ultra-minimally invasive surgery – also known as surgery without incisions.

Surgical fellows play an instrumental role in developing state-of-the-art approaches to precision medicine. The training, experience, and expertise that they gain with the GTx Program at The Princess Margaret will have a ripple effect on surgical oncology and discovery around the world.

Leaving a Lasting Legacy

Jane Leckey was a teenager in her first year of university when she flew headfirst off a horse and into a wall during a show jumping competition. She didn't know it at the time, but this fluke traumatic event likely saved her life.

"After the accident I was diagnosed with a malignant brain tumour that I may have had since birth. We're not entirely sure," says Jane. "They suspect that the crash caused the swelling that eventually led to the symptoms, that led to the diagnosis."

Thankfully the tumour was successfully excised and Jane quickly bounced back. "My parents loved to remind me of how one of my earliest questions coming out of surgery was 'well, when can I get back on a horse?'" she says.

For decades following her first brush with cancer, Jane lived a full life. She got married, got divorced and established a career in corporate communications. "Cancer was really not a thing that I gave much thought to until my second diagnosis," says Jane, who was diagnosed with breast cancer shortly after she turned 50.

Fortunately, she was treated at The Princess Margaret. Jane describes the care she received as "absolutely outstanding in every respect," noting the hospital's staff is "second to none" and "displayed a sense of empathy, passion and support."

One fateful day, while she was receiving one of her last rounds of radiation treatment, Jane saw a Yoga to Conquer Cancer poster that piqued her interest. As an avid yogi, she decided to sign up and call on her friends, family and coworkers to help her raise money for the cause. Within weeks she became one of the event's top fundraisers and was asked to be a guest speaker on event day. It was then that she realized, "I can actually make a difference. I can do something that delivers tangible results for future patients and their families."

Despite a near crippling fear of public speaking, she felt completely at ease talking to a crowd about cancer, knowing that her candour would help other people who might be feeling ashamed, embarrassed or fearful. "I finally found my voice," Jane says. "It was clear that sharing my story could make a real difference."

After a successful surgery and 21 rounds of radiation, Jane overcame cancer a second time and emerged with a new outlook on life. "I often joke that getting cancer again was a kick in the ass that I didn't realize I needed," Jane says. "It has enabled and reminded me to focus on what really matters. It has also motivated me to ask, 'what are you waiting for?'"

It wasn't until the spring of 2020, when her eldest brother died suddenly just three weeks after being diagnosed with stage 4 lung cancer, that Jane decided she wanted to contribute to The Princess Margaret in a different way. Since her brother didn't have a will when he was diagnosed, Jane and her family had to scramble to get one drawn up, signed and validated before he lost the cognitive capacity to sign it. "It reinforced to me that I really needed to get my affairs in order," says Jane. "I have worked long and hard to establish an estate that I eventually want to go to my charities of choice . . . I would be absolutely devastated if the estate that I've built up ended up in the hands of government."

With that in mind, Jane sat down with a lawyer and updated her last will and testament. "Including The Princess Margaret in my will was an easy decision, and I hope my foresight and openness will motivate other folks to consider making the same pledge," she says. "Estate planning is something that can – and should – be done at all stages of life."

Today Jane is a healthy, happy nature enthusiast, fundraiser and proud member of **The Princess Margaret's J.C.B. Grant Society**, which was formed to thank special donors who have made Conquering Cancer part of their own legacy.

"Cancer has changed my life in a million ways, most of them positive," says Jane. "It's enabled me to create a community of friends and loved ones and provide support to them at a time of need. I feel so privileged to be able to serve as a resource for [friends] and for people whom I've never met. This is one of the great benefits of doing an article like this;

I know that I am helping people whom I have never met and may never meet. How cool is that?!"



Net fundraising and lottery revenue (\$ millions):




Distinct Revenue Streams

Targeted Cancer Therapy Gave Jenny Her Life Back

Jenny and Mark were just starting their life together as a happily married couple when a diagnosis changed everything.

The day they returned home from a honeymoon spent exploring Egypt, Dubai, and the Maldives, Jenny went to the doctor to investigate a twitch in her eye that had left her mouth drooping. “I knew something was wrong,” she says. Then, the unthinkable happened: Jenny was diagnosed with stage 4 lung cancer which had spread to her brain causing a tumour to develop.

“Everything went blank. Silent,” says Jenny through tears. “At first, I thought about Mark. I just got married and I felt so bad for him because I was diagnosed with cancer...I didn’t know what was going to happen.”

The diagnosis was surprising not only because Jenny was a young, active person, but because of where the cancer originated in her body. “I don’t drink or smoke,” says Jenny. Her specific cancer type came down to chance. “It’s a mutation that is common in Asian females. The doctor said, ‘it’s just bad luck.’”

One thing that wasn’t unlucky was the timing of Jenny’s diagnosis. “My doctor said that without the treatment, I would have lived four to six weeks.”

Thankfully Jenny was quickly referred to The Princess Margaret under the care of Dr. Geoffrey Liu, a clinician scientist specializing in molecular genomics and pharmacogenomics.

“They [gave us] so much hope and so much courage,” says Mark. “[Dr. Liu] said we have a treatment for you that’s extremely targeted which did not exist years ago and if and when that stops working I have more tools in my toolbox.”

The Princess Margaret Radiation Oncology Team treated Jenny’s brain tumour with Gamma Knife surgery, a recent advancement in radiation therapy that uses computer-guided planning to target brain tumors. Despite its name, this procedure does not involve any incisions. Instead, the Gamma Knife delivers beams of highly focused radiation, precisely to the targeted area of the brain, specifically in the shape of the tumour, while sparing the surrounding normal tissue.

This type of personalized, targeted cancer treatment is a breakthrough that gives doctors the ability to reduce the disabling side effects that come with radiating the entire brain. “Long term side effects such as memory loss and reduced cognitive abilities are greatly reduced or even eliminated,” says Dr. Liu. “This significantly maintains quality of life longer.”

Jenny was also prescribed Osimertinib, a molecularly targeted drug used to treat metastatic lung cancer. The Princess Margaret was heavily involved in its clinical trials. “[These] drugs are indeed revolutionary in controlling the cancer for up to years,” says Dr. Liu. “Well over 4 out of 5 patients will have their cancers shrink, with some benefiting only for a few months, but others for years. This is the epitome of a “take one pill a day to keep the doctor away” scenario, and in many cases, we are seeing these patients four times a year, allowing them to focus on their regular lives instead of their cancer.”

Since she started her targeted treatment plan, Jenny has gone from having MRIs every three months to only needing one every six months. She has returned to her job with TD Bank and is back to enjoying life with Mark and their poodle Rocky. Simply by taking one pill a day, she is managing her cancer, and can continue to live a very rich and fulfilling life. Mark and Jenny’s future is bright and the love that helped carry them through is now stronger than ever.

Jenny and her story embody the progress we have made in cancer therapy, thanks to the generous supporters who have funded this critical work. The Princess Margaret is continually working on discovering new treatment options. We’re at the forefront of creating new therapies and treatments so that if Osimertinib no longer works for Jenny, we’ll have other options to save her life. This is the work that our donors are funding. This is how progress in cancer is made.
